- Evacuation Trailer Training with CERT on July 16, 2016. Joe trying to make contact with Red Cross to renew contacts. Will do another training for the CERT in Lockwood.
- Working on October 15 Quad County Hazmat Exercise at AZZ.
- Looking at 2017 exercise and it might be a good idea to work with Aqua Metals. A company that recycles lead acid batteries. Recently reviewed emergency response plan.
- DEM held a mid-year Emergency Managers Conference in Carson City on July 14. Discussing THIRA
- NEPA Membership (Nevada Emergency Preparedness Association) open to public, private emergency management, law, fire, health, LEPC members, VOAD. Will send a membership form out to LEPC Members. Been approached to speak at IAEM in Atlanta, GA. Will partner with state to do an annual preparedness conference along with DEM.
- J. Nevin- St. 75 have a ladder truck in service now. Dual response will respond to everything in the industrial park to areas that they can access. Engine responds to auto aid calls on I-80. 4 person staffing- engine and ambulance to a calls.

Cooperating Local Emergency Planning Committee Members Report on Activities

- Marena Works- flu clinic in Lockwood at the Senior Center in September. VC Clinic is doing very well. At some point can see expansion to another day per week. Leslie Thompson is a PA and is a good fit. 10-12 people to be seen per day. Good consistent service. Flu Clinic in VC in conjunction with Senior Center. Mark Twain Health Fair on October 8. Joe- POD situation NV Health would partner.
- Jim Regan- plant is putting in a new water system. Down to 2 emergency managers.
- Dean Haymore- Aqua Metals Grand Opening on July 28. Tesla is having a big grand opening on July 29 invitation only. 30,000 sq ft tent- 2000 invited guests. August 15-17 Tesla doing hiring and training at St. 75. Hiring another 150. Switch planning Grand Opening in November. Fulcrum- got a CofO full operations. Chewy.com 385 Milan. New customer at 700 Milan Thrive Market- health food and supplements. BI Nutricriticals- food processing. Another food processing company. Working with a group for a new Marriott hotel at the Corner of USA Pkwy and Electric. One of 4 that they are planning on putting in the park. Across the Street from Randa for Maverick and a Food Company- 16,000 24 hour buffet and gentleman's club. Tesla permitted another 3,000 sq ft of buildings. Another increase in construction workers. Experiencing industrial injuries. USA Parkway will start paving in August. Picking up some new single family dwellings in the Highlands and VC. USGS is doing a water report at the August 2 Commission Meeting. Joe would like to meet with Dean to get update on the Tesla operation.

Then will move out to Painted Rock. Did some fuels reduction work in Six Mile Canyon. Did some fuel reduction work on Cartwright and Lousetown. Still working in Bailey's Canyon off Geiger Summit. Doing some fire break road work in Virginia City on the West side.
- Tom Taromina- Amateur Radio HAM radio. Running HAM class for about 12 folks in the Highlands. Wanted to start a volunteer group of leaders in TRI- not much response, putting that to sleep. Center for Business Excellence- non-profit, no appetite for having a single point of contact. Close up that center.
- Joe- be vigilant about what goes on around you. See something, say something. State Fusion Center wants to put on an 8hr class. Joe & Melanie get together to get this done. Working with Jim Lopey on this.
