I own the Silver Stope which is diagonally across the street of the proposed venue. Many people stop there to admire the view and take pictures. I would like to know if there will be some sort of permanent or temporary type of roofing, walls, and restrooms.

The businesses on the block that have public restrooms are bars, hotel, and restaurants. Not all allow usage of their facilities to the non-consuming public. The shops do not have public restrooms, thus placing an additional burden on those that do allow usage if they continue to do so.

In reference to the "live music and dancing" during the day, my concern is the noise as the sound carries straight into the stores. Although there is a noise ordinance, it is difficult to control and will affect daily operations. I note with experience of almost 20 years in my location that it would be a major problem.
