**MISDEMEANOR RECKLESS DRIVING ADMONISHMENT OF RIGHTS
Reckless Driving – Drive in/or organize an unauthorized speed contest**

- _____ 1. I am the Defendant in this case. I have not taken any medication or any other substance that today interferes in any way with my ability to understand what we are doing now. I am taking medication(s) that I am supposed to take.
- _____ 2. I am the Defendant in this case and understand I have been charged with **RECKLESS DRIVING, A VIOLATION OF SCC 10.04.080/NRS 484B.653(1)(B)/484B(1)(c)** in that I drove in or organized an unauthorized speed contest in Storey County, Nevada, on the _____ day of _____ 20__

PENALTIES AND RIGHTS:

- _____ 3. I understand the State must prove the elements in Item 2 beyond a reasonable doubt.
- _____ 4. I understand the following possible punishments:

Reckless Driving by driving in or organizing a speed contest is an “enhanceable” offense with the following punishments:

- (a) For the first offense:
- (1) A fine of not less than \$250 but not more than \$1,000;
 - (2) Not less than 50 hours, but not more than 99 hours, of community service; and
 - (3) You may be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 6 months.
 - (4) The Court will issue an order suspending your driver’s license for a period of not less than 6 months but not more than 2 years and require you to surrender all drivers licenses held by you.
 - (5) You will be required to surrender your driver’s license(s) to the Court.
 - (6) The Court may issue an order impounding, for a period of 15 days, any vehicle that is registered to you if the vehicle was used in the commission of the offense.
- (b) For the second offense and each subsequent offense:
- (1) A fine of not less than \$1,000 but not more than \$1,500;
 - (2) Not less than 100 hours, but not more than 199 hours of community service; and
 - (3) You may be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 6 months.
 - (4) The Court will issue an order suspending your driver’s license for a period of not less than 6 months but not more than 2 years and require you to surrender all drivers licenses held by you.
 - (5) You will be required to surrender your driver’s license(s) to the Court.
 - (6) The Court will issue an order impounding, for a period of 30 days, any vehicle that is registered to you if the vehicle was used in the commission of the offense.
- (c) For the third and each subsequent offense, shall be punished:
- (1) By a fine of not less than \$1,500 but not more than \$2,000; or
 - (2) Not less than 200 hours of community service, and
 - (3) You may be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 6 months.
 - (4) The Court will issue an order suspending your driver’s license for a period of not less than 6 months but not more than 2 years and require you to surrender all drivers licenses held by you.
 - (5) You will be required to surrender your driver’s license(s) to the Court.
 - (6) The Court will issue an order impounding, for a period of 30 days, any vehicle that is registered to you if the vehicle was used in the commission of the offense.

- _____ 5. I understand the Court is not limited by the minimum penalty and can impose additional jail time and fines up to the maximum allowed by law.
- _____ 6. I understand the State will use this and any other constitutionally valid prior conviction of RECKLESS DRIVING for any subsequent RECKLESS DRIVING violation.
- _____ 7. I understand I have the right to have an attorney to represent me.
- _____ 8. I understand there are significant dangers and disadvantages to representing myself and the assistance of an
