### Monthly Updates

Began working on the 2019/20 Budget. No additional capital acquisition or personnel submitted to the Comptrollers Office.

We have had an employee resign from our department. At this time, due to the cross training efforts over the past eighteen-months, we are proposing to not fill this position. It is felt that our current staffing level will be more efficient and able to keep up with all KNOWN projects in the county. This will be reflected in the upcoming tentative budget submittal as a department savings.

In preparation of the upcoming tentative budget submittal, we have evaluated the total number of existing work stations at both the McCarran office and Virginia City office. Through this evaluation we have determined that we may be able to purchase tablets for personnel, thereby combining fixed work stations and iPads into one and have a considerable savings in the draft budget. Instead of needing fifteen work stations, we can crunch that down into eight tablets and then personnel take them into the field with them. When they arrive at an office, they simply plug into a docking station and complete their work.

Working on reappointing the board of appeals as they expire in March.
