

10 **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

11 This Administrative Order is being issued in response to the recent outbreak of  
12 Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Nevada. On March 15, 2020, Governor Stephen  
13 Sisolak declared a state of emergency and closed all public, private and charter schools K-  
14 12 until April 6, 2020. On March 18, 2020, Governor Stephen Sisolak closed all non-  
15 essential services state-wide and requested all Nevadans stay home to implement social  
16 distancing. During this time, it is critical to prevent the spread of COVID-19 among  
17 members of the court, counsel, staff, the public, and our valuable community partners;

19 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED effective March 25, 2020, the First Judicial District Court  
20 and Virginia Township Justice Court shall reduce the hours open to the public for the Clerk's  
21 Offices from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. subject to change dependent upon available staffing and  
22 further court order. Provisions have been established to ensure that emergency and/or  
23 necessary matters are timely processed following applicable mandates.

24 IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that eviction proceedings are suspended until  
25 further order of the court.

26 The First Judicial District Court will allow documents to be submitted by email in the  
27 form of PDF documents to Clerk@storeycounty.org or by facsimile (775) 847-0921 pursuant to

1 Nevada Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 6 Computing and Extending Time. The Clerk's Office  
2 will print, review, and file or receive stamp documents. All documents will be reviewed by the  
3 court and any format requirements or changes will be communicated to the parties. Original  
4 documents are required to follow unless otherwise approved by the court. Documents hand-  
5 delivered or received by mail will be processed.

6  
7 The Virginia Township Justice Court will allow documents to be submitted by email in  
8 the form of PDF documents to [jp@storeycounty.org](mailto:jp@storeycounty.org) or by facsimile to 775-847-0915, and will  
9 be processed pursuant to Justice Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 6. The Clerk's Office will print,  
10 review, and file or receive stamp documents. Documents received electronically by 11:59 p.m.  
11 will be deemed filed. All documents will be reviewed by the court and any format requirements  
12 or changes will be communicated to the parties. Original documents are required to follow  
13 unless otherwise approved by the court. Documents hand-delivered or received by mail will be  
14 processed.

15 Drop boxes will be made available at the Storey County Courthouse for ease and  
16 convenience for the public to drop off documents to be filed in the First Judicial District Court  
17 and the Virginia Township Justice Court.

18  
19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the courtrooms for each respective court will be  
20 open for scheduled court hearings Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The  
21 number of the public permitted in the courtrooms will be limited to minimize the risk of  
22 COVID-19 transmission.


23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the First Judicial District Court Clerk's Office
