MEMORANDUM

Re: STOREY COVID MITIGATION & GOVERNOR CONFERENCE UPDATE

Good morning,

Working together we hope to mitigate and maintain "low transmission" Covid numbers in our workplace and county. We are composed of unique offices and functions, so please reach Tobi at HR to discuss any special mitigation needs. Please accept the following update and awareness notes.

1. **Board meetings will continue to be in-person and by Zoom.** Remote attendance is encouraged.
2. **Mask mandates for the vaccinated and non-vaccinated will be required August 13 if Storey County maintains "moderate" or higher transmission.** Standard CDC mask mandates remain for now.
3. **Direct public calls about testing and vaccination to Carson City HHS:**
 - a. **800.401.0946**
 - b. **Gethealthycarsoncity.org**
4. **Today's Governor press conference stated:** mask mandate unchanged, no business "rollbacks", and schools will open with masks. A health task-force will advise later on: mandatory vaccines for higher education and institutions, and masks and mitigation for "large gatherings" and similar events.
5. **VCTC will work with merchants to maintain hand sanitizer stations on C Street.**
6. **Contact Lara Mather for hand sanitizer.** There are pallets and gallons available.
7. Contract cleaning service will continue **cleaning high public use restrooms.**
8. **Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and face.**
9. **Sanitize hands after using shared** keyboards, pens, staplers, copy machines, etc.
10. **Sanitize vehicle** steering wheels, knobs and shifters, and other surfaces. Air out vehicle before use.
11. **Sanitize doorknobs** and touched surfaces frequently.
12. Keep workstations **at least 6' apart** if possible.
13. **Have employees work remotely if practical.** Please see HR for "Telecommuting Agreement".
14. To maximize social distancing, **close doors between shared offices.**
15. **Customers should be separated** from the office by plexiglass or other means.
16. **Restroom fans should remain on** for clean air.
17. CDC and other standard COVID prevention measures will continue as well.

This notice does not override Fire, EMS, law enforcement, and other statutory requirements or exemptions. Carson City Health & Human Services (through "Quad-County") oversees and administers all COVID-related health matters, contact-tracing, and prevention orders in accordance with HIPAA.
